Operation of the SOSeFLARE™:

- Batteries are pre-installed. To turn on, hold the strobe body in one hand and turn lens clockwise until the light turns on. Observe the ON/OFF Marks and arrows on rim under the clear lens.
- To turn off, turns lens counterclockwise and continue to turn it one full turn after the light is extinguished. This prevents the light from coming on accidentally.

If Your Strobe Floods:

- 1. Remove and discard batteries.
- 2. Flush flashlight and parts with warm, fresh water.
- 3. Dry, then check for damage or corrosion.
- 4. Return to factory or replace damaged parts as necessary.

General Strobe and Battery Information:

Batteries:

For maximum brightness and burn time, we recommend Ultralife CR123 cell Lithium-Alkaline batteries. Install all batteries with the positive (+) end up, facing up out of the light.

 Check operation momentarily before each trip. Replace batteries every 5 years for safety.

Proper Use:

Strobe electronics can fail if not properly handled; the LED strobe module contains delicate electronics.

Refrain from dropping, banging or otherwise jolting this strobe. Cushion strobe during transport and storage to prevent breakage due to vibration and unintentional jolting.

Maintenance:

Occasionally clean and lightly lubricate lens threads and Orings with silicone grease. Never use aerosol spray lubricants.

Caution

Remove batteries from strobe during periods of storage to prevent damage from cell leakage.

Do not look at the flashing light. Eye damage can occur from prolonged exposure.

Limited Lifetime Warranty:

Tektite guarantees that its products are free from defects in material and workmanship for the normal life of the product. This warranty includes LEDs; and excludes O-rings, Lanyards, Batteries, Bulbs and strobe electronics, which are wear items; these items are covered for 60 days from date of purchase, or their normal service life as stated on the package, whichever comes first. This warranty is to the original owner only, and does not cover damage due to normal wear, abuse, alteration, poor maintenance, accidents, loss or negligence. Our liability is strictly limited to repair or replacement of the product.

To make Warranty effective, the original purchaser must return the damaged unit to Tektite, postage paid, together WITH PROOF OF PURCHASE AND \$9.00 FOR S+H.
